


Assessment Reference Data

Reference data in an assessment is important, secondary data that needs to be included, but not actually assessed. If a relationship between the assessment and a reference object type has been created, the relationship and reference form elements can be used to view, add, or edit data on a reference object. Examples of assessment reference data include business units, locations, departments, products, teams, or legislation.

If objects in an assessment should **not** have instances (new versions) created and should only be used as references, admins can deselect the **Assessment Data** toggle beside an object type from the **Configuration tab** of the **Edit Assessments** page. This toggle is enabled for each object type by default.
