## **Overview**

The Two-way Email feature allows users in Resolver to reply to Object Submitters through email.

- 2. Click the **Send** button at the bottom of the message text box.
  - Both the Resolver user and Submitter will receive the reply message thread. If the Submitter chooses to remain Confidential, their Personal Identifiable Information (PII) will remain hidden.
- (Optional) Internal Users can add comments to the Comments section if Comments are selected from the Form Features section on the Edit Header Section pop-up on the Form, keeping both Comments and Emails in one place.
