

# **Creating a New Sub Process**

#### **Overview**


Users can create a sub process within the system through the **Library** section, in order to manually add a new sub process to the system for use within the Internal Controls Management application. User can also add multiple sub processes by using either the data import feature or integration feature.

### **User Account Requirements**

The user account used to log into Resolver must be added to the Internal Controls Team user group.

### **Navigation**


1. From the *Home* screen, click the **Home** dropdown menu.



Home Dropdown Menu


2. From the **Home** dropdown menu, click the **Library** link.

3. From the *Org Structure* screen, click the **Processes** tab.




Processes Tab

## **Creating a New Sub Process**


1. From the *Processes* screen, click the + Create Sub Process button.





+ Create Sub Process Button


2. From the *Create a New Sub Process* screen, enter the sub process name in the **Sub Process Name** field.



Sub Process Name Field


3. Enter a brief description outlining the sub process in the **Description** field.





Description Field


4. Click the **Create** button to add the process to the system for use with the Internal Controls Management application.



Create Button


5. Click the **Add Existing Processes** link to add an existing process to the sub process.





Add Existing Processes Link


6. From the *Add Existing Processes* pop-up, click the + **Add** link next to a process to add it to the sub process.


7. **(Optional)** Enter a process name in the **Search** field to search for a process that is not listed on the **Showing 9 most recently created process** list.






Search Field

Risks Tab


9. (Optional) Click the *Controls* tab to add an existing or new control to the sub process.
